## **MEMBERSHIP POLICY AND ACCESS TO TEE AND TOURNAMENTS**

Except for authorized Junior events, the long course is available only after 3:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays; weekdays except for between 12 noon and 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday, and within the general limitations. Junior Club Champion may play in Senior Club Championship.

## **DRESS CODE**

All members and guests are required to conform to the dress code regulations which have been established.

### **Golf Course and Practice Areas**

- Shirts must be tucked in and have a collar. A 'collar' can be the standard style, turtleneck style or the mock neck style.
- Golf shoes must be worn. Socks or sockettes must be worn.
- Soft spikes are mandatory.

### **Clubhouse**

- Hats may not be worn in the mixed lounge, dining room, or ballroom.
- Appropriate footwear should be worn in all areas of the clubhouse – shoes or sandals.
- Children 12 years of age and over shall dress in accordance with the adult regulations. Children 11 years of age and under should wear neat and clean clothes.

### **Unacceptable Dress**

Blue jeans, short shorts, cut-offs, tank tops, sleeveless/collarless/team shirts, shirts with slogans, baseball-style hats worn backwards, T-shirts, running pants, track or jogging suits and paratrooper (cargo) style pants.
