MEMBERSHIP POLICY AND ACCESS TO TEE AND TOURNAMENTS

Except for authorized Junior events, the long course is available only after 3:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays; weekdays except for between 12 noon and 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday, and within the general limitations. Students may play in Opening and Closing Events, as well as Club Championship.

DRESS CODE

All members and guests are required to conform to the dress code regulations which have been established.

Golf Course and Practice Areas

- Shirts must be tucked in and have a collar. A 'collar' can be the standard style, turtleneck style or the mock neck style.
- Golf shoes must be worn. Socks or sockettes must be worn.
- Soft spikes are mandatory.

Clubhouse

- Hats may not be worn in the mixed lounge, dining room, or ballroom.
- Appropriate footwear should be worn in all areas of the clubhouse – shoes or sandals.
- Children 12 years of age and over shall dress in accordance with the adult regulations. Children 11 years of age and under should wear neat and clean clothes.

Unacceptable Dress

Blue jeans, short shorts, cut-offs, tank tops, sleeveless/collarless/team shirts, shirts with slogans, baseball-style hats worn backwards, T-shirts, running pants, track or jogging suits and paratrooper (cargo) style pants.
